Sanction is hereby accorded to the release of an amount of Rs.4.96 Lacs (Rupees Four Lacs and Ninety Six Thousand Only) under Centrally Sponsored Scheme Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojna (RKVY) out of unspent balance 2014-15 for utilization during 2015-16 and placement of the same at the disposal of Chief Agriculture Officer Baramulla as per the component-wise breakup indicated in the Annexure "A" to this order, strictly in accordance with the guidelines laid down under the scheme.

**The release of funds is subject to the following conditions:-**

1. The funds shall be utilized as per the Approved Work Plan 2014-15.
2. The implementing officers shall ensure that project-wise accounts are maintained and are subject to normal process of statutory Audit, an inventory of the assets created under the projects be preserved and assets that are no longer required shall be transferred to the Nodal Department for its use and re-deployment, wherever possible.
3. The Implementing Officer shall not incur/expenditure towards maintenance of assets, Salary, Transport, POL, TA/DA, Purchase of Vehicle, Foreign Visits/Tours including study tours of farmers abroad and other consumables out of RKVY. However expenses towards Hiring of Manpower on outsourcing/Contractual basis can be meant within 1% allocation earmarked for administrative expenses with the approval of SLSC. This amount shall be consider for release after receiving proper proposals and shall include DPR preparation.
4. The implementing Officer shall utilized the funds for training/awareness camps/demonstration/publicity out of availability under Support to State Extension Programme for Extension Reforms (ATMA) as per the guidelines, in the first instance.
5. The implementing officer shall implement the programme/activity/components on the cost norms/guidelines/subsidy component at par, which are admissible/permissible in the normal Centrally Sponsored Scheme Department for RKVY Plan during 2014-15.
6. The DDO shall ensure that the funds released are utilized prudently and judiciously as per the guidelines of the scheme and in no case he should book the expenditure just for the sake of expenditure
7. The implementing officer shall restrict the expenditure to the actual availability of funds and **no liability shall be created in any case.**
8. The implementing agencies shall obtain necessary sanctions from the competent authorities in advance before incurring the expenditure where-ever required.
9. The expenditure shall be incurred only after observing all codal formalities.
10. The implementing officer shall ensure that there is no overlapping/duplication in adoption of Schemes/incurring of expenditure from any other scheme of the State or Central Government.
11. The implementing officer shall furnish progress both in physical and financial on monthly basis for its onward submission to Administrative Department.
12. The implementing officer shall furnish progress both in physical and financial on monthly basis for its onward submission to Administrative Department.

13. The expenditure shall be incurred only after observing all codal formalities and in accordance with the guidelines of the scheme.
14. The implementing agency shall send utilization certificate of funds by or before 31.03.2016 alongwith Physical and Financial Progress Reports.
16. No diversion of funds is permissible.
